
## Relational Actional Missional

# CHRISTIAN EDUCATION



It's often said, "What goes around, comes around." I've been in ministry long enough to see that there is a lot of truth in this little proverb. Of course there should be, as it is essentially a modern rephrasing of "you reap what you sow" (Galatians 6:7).

In the late 70's our church purchased land on the outskirts of northwest San Antonio. We had outgrown our current location and had no more space for a growing vision. That vision included not only a larger auditorium, but also ample classroom space to start a Christian school. Founded in 1978, by John and Ruth Bell, King's Academy had a strong thirty year run. I don't have the exact numbers, but 1,000's of students and 100's of alumni (myself included) had their formative years shaped at 8635 Callaghan Road through the ministry of teachers who labored faithfully, led by Bob Sayer as Principal. I honor them for their labor of love and lasting impact they've had in my life.

Thirty years is a long time. During that time, a lot of things changed. For many reasons (that are beyond the scope of this brief article), it was decided that the school had fulfilled it's vision, and it was time to close the doors. It was a difficult decision and the elder's of the church took several years to deliberate. Even at that time in 2008 when the school closed, the door was left open for the possibility of having a school again.

I've long had a desire to have a Christian school again as a part of our ministry. I'm very blessed to report that this fall (thirteen years later), we will once again have a Christian School at Destiny Church. God is good!
